Notes on assessment:

- Wherever possible, students are encouraged to provide evidence of their learning and understanding using their strengths and interests. Students are encouraged to approach the teacher and propose their own ideas of how they would like to demonstrate the intended learning.
- Tests and quizzes can be redone to demonstrate that the student has learned the material. If the student can demonstrate that they understand the learning goals, they will not be penalized academically for first attempts to learn. Test retakes must be done within a reasonable time-frame as arranged with the teacher and students must provide evidence of their efforts to understand the learning. (Notes, review with teacher, explanation of what was done).
- Assessment is based on where the student is in relation to the intended learning goals. Students may receive work without letter grades or totals. Students may receive work with comments or circles or they may be given verbal feedback to support their learning. Students may be asked to make corrections and return their work to the teacher if they have not provided sufficient evidence that they have met the learning goals.

Notes on Core Competencies:

- Opportunities for self-reflection on our learning and personal development will be integrated throughout the term.
- We will use SMART language (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Realistic, Timely) when planning and setting goals.
- We will use self and peer assessments in order to strengthen our metacognitive awareness in relation to the Core Competencies.
